MCRC News

The March Board meeting was attended by members Dave Grenier, John Miller, Maurice Spence, Wayne Smith, Joe Klein, Dave Cutaia, Dave Hasler, Ray Gilbert, and Joe Kenrick. The meeting started at 10:00 AM in the MCRC clubhouse, and President Dave Grenier opened the meeting.

**Secretary's Report (Joe Kenrick): The minutes from the prior meeting were accepted as written. Joe Klein expects to receive the Club's Charter and Insurance Certificate from the AMA by the end of the month.

**Treasurer's Report (Wayne Smith): Wayne distributed the Club's financials for discussion. He noted that the Club is doing okay financially and mentioned a recent payment of \$3,500 for the second half of the roof

replacement bill for the Clubhouse. He passed out the "No Fly List" for 2025, which was discussed by the board.

**Safety Report (Maurice Spence): Maurice addressed a couple of issues, including the relocation and restocking of the First Aid Kit, which was moved out of the kitchen to the open area. The First Aid Kit can be more easily accessed by the MCRC members in case of an emergency.



He noted that Lithium-ion batteries used for the training models were stored in a wooden box. Additionally, there were reports of kids flying small models (Park Flyers) inside the fences at the Field, which sparked further discussion.

**Membership Report (Dave Cutaia): The current membership count, believed to be less than 100, was discussed. Wayne S. verified that the number of members is currently 97.

- **Field Maintenance (Joe Klein): Joe mentioned there is a "deck problem" with one of the mowers. He also acknowledged that the MCRC field looks great, thanks to his crew.
- **Training Report (Joe Klein): Ray Gilbert has been primarily handling the training lately. Ray is returning to his northern home by the end of May.
- **Control-Line Report (Wayne Smith): There wasn't much to report regarding control-line activities.
- **Unfinished Business: John Miller will coordinate with Wayne Smith regarding cash on hand for kitchen supplies.
- **New Business**: There were no new issues raised.

**Postmortem Discussion on the Dick Coles Event (Dave Hasler): Dave Hasler led an extensive discussion following the event, highlighting the significantly decreased participation compared to the previous year. He proposed the possibility of totally revamping the event and scheduling it at a different time of year to align it with other Club activities. Many ideas emerged, but it was clear that there was no simple solution for improving the event's success. Further discussions and planning will be necessary to determine the future direction of the event and how it fits into the broader scope of Club activities.

- **Auction Proceeds (Dave Cutaia): Dave reported the following proceeds from the auction held during the Dick Coles Event:
- **Items Not Sold**: 9 items did not sell.
- **Items Sold**: A total of 22 items sold for a combined total of \$1,180.00 dollars.
- **MCRC Auction Fee**: 10% of sales = \$118.00 dollars.
- **Nancy Iancelli, Tony Iancelli's widow Total**: \$1,062.00 dollars.

Nancy Iancelli was present at the MCRC field during the auction, and we handed her the \$1,062.00 dollars.

David also discussed items that were not raffled off during the event, deciding that these will be advertised for sale in May's Newsletter.

Accidents do Occur!

In March, David Cutaia had an accident while operating one of his radio-controlled planes, which required him to undergo surgery on his forearm at the hospital. He accidentally left the battery connected to the electronic speed controller (ESC), and the propeller of the airplane sliced his left forearm. The lesson learned from this

accident is to always disconnect the battery and remove it from the airplane when you leave the flight line. Remember to exercise caution when operating any radio-controlled aircraft, as accidents can happen.
